

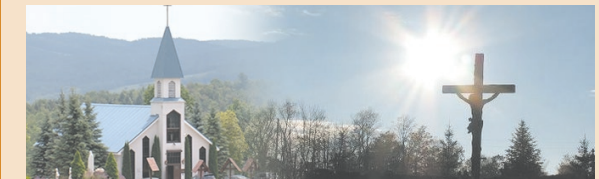
IN THE ARENA 8 PM

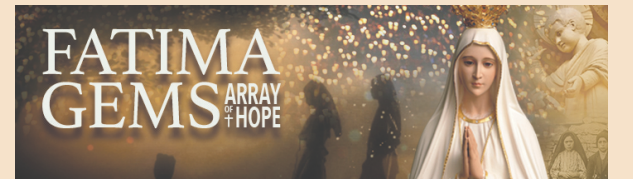


FOCUS TV 8:30 PM
