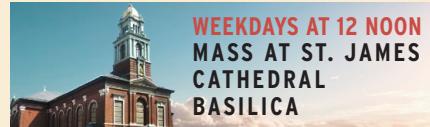
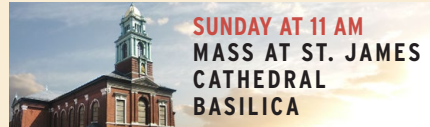

William Wallace, played by Mel Gibson in the movie *Braveheart*, is the epitome of courage. He refused to cower in the face of English oppression. He was willing to risk everything to oppose injustice but he was also not reckless in his confrontation of the English. Indeed, he was strategic in how he approached every conflict. Perhaps this week we might reflect on the ways in which we might be courageous? How do we labor to overcome offenses against human dignity? Are we reckless and rash in our speech and the decisions we make? Are we afraid to attract the ire and scorn of those who might oppose us? May God bless you.
