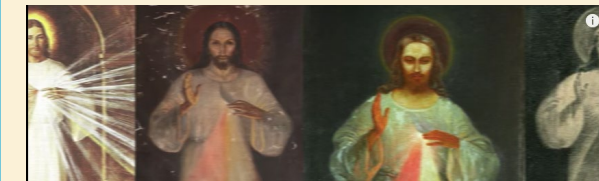
THE OTHER 99 T.Y.M.E.S. 9 PM
