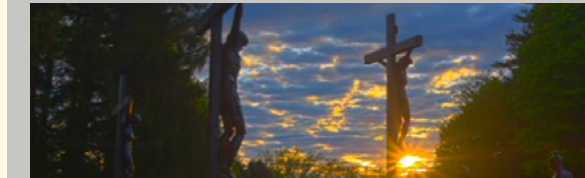
### SUNDAY 4/2

As we continue to move through this season of repentance, we celebrate the fifth Sunday of Lent. In the past, this week was known as Passion Sunday, and the Church entered into Passion Tide. Traditionally, this time was marked by the veiling or covering of all the statues and religious images in the church. This practice is associated with Saint John's Gospel when Jesus said, "Very truly, I tell you, before Abraham was, I Am." This revelation stirred up the anger of the people and they attempted to stone Him but He hid Himself in the temple. On this "Passion" Sunday, we remember that Jesus raised Lazarus, his friend, from the dead. He will do the same for you and me. He will set us free from sin and the wages of sin-death!
