

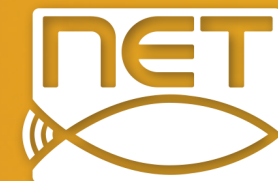

This past week the Muslim people celebrated Eid al-Adha or the "Festival of Sacrifice." The feast is a celebration of the patriarch Abraham's willingness to offer his son Ismael as a sacrifice to God. The Jewish/Christian Scriptures attest to the sacrificed son as Isaac. In Genesis 22 it is revealed that, just before the sacrifice is offered, an angel intervenes and a ram is offered in the son's place. In celebration of the profound faith of Abraham, Muslims offer an animal sacrifice. The meat from the sacrifice is equally shared by the family, the poor and needy, as well as neighbors. We as Christians offer the sacrifice of prayers and well wishes for our Muslim friends during these most holy days.
