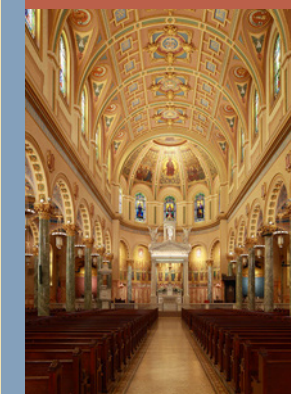

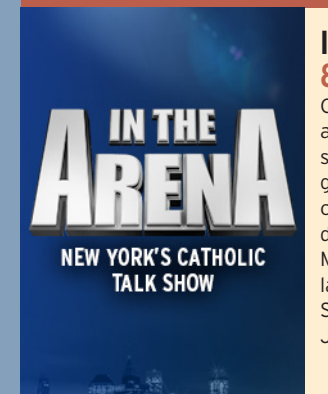
SUNDAY MASS AT THE CO-CATHEDRAL OF ST. JOSEPH 9 AM

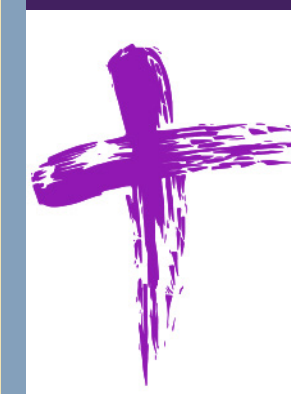

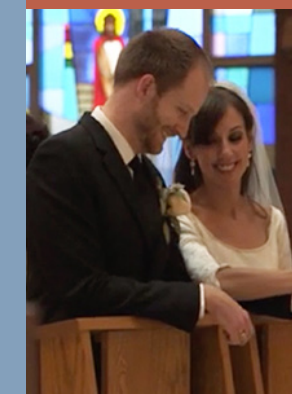
